Eligibility:

- a) The student should be an Indian National.
- b) The Applicant should have passed in Higher Secondary School Leaving Certificate Examination (HSSLC) 2021 conducted by MBOSE and be above 80th percentile of successful candidates in the relevant stream.
- c) The renewal will depend on promotion to the next class provided the scholar secures 50% or more marks or equivalent Grade Point Average in aggregate for the two preceding semesters or of the annual examination which determines his promotion to the next class. Renewal is subject to discipline and maintenance of attendance of at least 75% by the scholar.
- d) Pursuing a regular Course (not Correspondence or distance mode) from recognized institution.
- e) Income of both parents from all sources should not exceed ₹. 8.0 (Lakh) per annum

- 1. Merit-Cum-Means based Scholarship:** Merit-Cum-Means based Scholarship is a Central Sector Scheme. Muslims, Christians, Sikhs, Buddhist, Zoroastrians (Parsis) and Jains, pursuing Technical & Professional Courses at Under Graduate/Post Graduate level in an institution recognized by an appropriate authority who have secured not less than 50% marks or equivalent grade in the previous final examination are eligible for Merit Cum Means based Scholarship for the year 2021-22 to be awarded by the Ministry of Minority Affairs, Govt. of India. Income of both parents from all sources should not exceed ₹. 2.50 (Lakh) per annum. Applications for Merit Cum Means Based Scholarship are to be submitted on-line through the URL www.scholarships.gov.in Print out of duly filled-in application forms are also to be submitted to their respective institutions, along with all supporting documents. **Only Online application under Merit-Cum-Means based Scholarship Scheme will be accepted and no request for an Offline application will be entertained.**

Last date for submission of Online application for Fresh and Renewal scholarship by students is 30th November, 2021.

- 2. Post Matric Scholarship:** Post Matric Scholarship is a Central Sector Scheme. Under this scheme, scholarships are awarded to the meritorious Students from notified minority communities viz. Muslims, Christians, Sikhs, Buddhist, Zoroastrians (Parsis) and Jains, students pursuing any course in Government or Private institute from class XI to Ph.D level who have secured not less than 50% marks or equivalent grade in the previous final examination are eligible for Post Matric Scholarship for the year 2021-22 to be awarded by the Ministry of Minority Affairs, Govt. of India. Income of both parents from all sources should not exceed ₹. 2.0 (Lakh) per annum. Applications for Post Matric Scholarship are to be submitted on-line through the URL www.scholarships.gov.in. Print out of duly filled-in application forms are also to be submitted to their respective institutions along with all supporting documents. **Only Online application under Post Matric scholarship Scheme will be accepted and no request for an Offline application will be entertained.**

Last date for submission of Online application for Fresh and Renewal scholarship by students is 30th November, 2021.

- 3. Pre-Matric Scholarship:** Pre-Matric Scholarship is a Central Sector Scheme. Under this scheme, scholarships are awarded to the meritorious Students from notified minority communities viz. Muslims, Christians, Sikhs, Buddhist, Zoroastrians (Parsis) and Jains, pursuing studies in Government or Private School from Class I to Class X who have secured not less than 50% marks or equivalent grade in the previous final examination are eligible to apply for Pre-Matric Scholarship for the year 2021-22 to be awarded by the Ministry of Minority Affairs, Govt. of India. Income of both parents from all sources should not exceed ₹. 1.0 (Lakh) per annum. Applications for Post Matric Scholarship are to be submitted on-line through the URL www.scholarships.gov.in. Print out of duly filled-in application forms are also to be submitted to their respective institution along with all supporting documents. **Only Online application under Pre-Matric scholarship Scheme will be accepted and no request for an Offline application will be entertained.**

Last date for submission of Online application for Fresh and Renewal scholarship by students is 15th November, 2021.

 - d). Photo ID issued by Educational Institute (For Students) and
 - e). Certificate issued by Bank that should be duly attested, containing applicant's photo and Bank account number.
2. The Income ceiling of both the Parents/Guardian from all sources should not exceed ₹. 8.0 (lakh) per annum (Income certificate should be enclosed for fresh only).
3. Copy of previous class mark sheet is to be mandatorily enclosed with all Fresh and Renewal application.
4. All principals submitting the renewal application forms should submit a list of applicants along with the soft copy of the same in Excel format.
5. **The last date of submission of application forms will be on the 30th November 2021.** No application form will be accepted after the above mentioned date.
